A MESSAGE FROM OUR MINISTER

On Sunday 9th June... the church celebrates Pentecost. This has its origins in a Jewish festival called 'the Feast of Weeks'. It is... associated with two main events – the wheat harvest and the giving of the law to Moses on Mount Sinai. These 2 events link together in the Bible in the book of Exodus (chapter 34 if you want to find out more). In England the late May bank holiday used to be the day after Pentecost Sunday and

was a moveable date as it is fixed by being six weeks after Easter. Today in the (secular?) UK we have fixed the late May bank holiday to be the last Monday in May and introduced the (socialist) May day bank holiday at the start of May. In most of Europe... a bank holiday is still taken on the Monday which follows Pentecost Sunday.


The Feast of Weeks is one of the 3 main Jewish holidays, on each of which the Jews were supposed to make pilgrimage to the temple in the city of Jerusalem, the other two being Passover (Easter) and New Year (end of September). Pentecost is most notable in the Christian tradition as marking the founding of the early church. It was on this day that the promise of the Holy Spirit was poured out on the early disciples, an event that was to change their lives and most of the Western world for ever.


This pouring out of the Spirit was followed by signs and wonders; people were healed, evil spirits were cast out, people spoke in languages they had not learned and prophesied. It is significant that this occurred at the Feast of Weeks festival, as Jews from all over the empire would have gathered in Jerusalem for the feast. The good news of the resurrection of Jesus and the powerful outpouring of the Holy Spirit would then have been relayed back to all corners of the Roman Empire.

This filling of the Holy Spirit is a core belief of the Christian church today. I became a Christian in 1973 and this empowering by the Holy Spirit changed my life forever. Pentecost would be a good time to turn to God and see your life transformed for ever (though in reality any time is a good time).




